INFORMATION ABOUT THE CZECH CITIZENSHIP EXAM

The website is available in Czech, English, Ukrainian, Russian and Vietnamese.

The Czech Citizenship Exam is organised by the **Institute for Language and Preparatory Studies of Charles University in Prague (ILPS CU)**.

The Czech Citizenship Exam comprises two parts:

- Czech Life and Institutions Exam (written form)
- Czech Language Exam (written and oral form)

The following fees have to be paid for the Czech Citizenship Exam:

- The fee for the Czech Life and Institutions Exam: CZK 1,600
- The fee for the Czech Language Exam: CZK 3,300

The applicant will receive information about how to pay for the exam upon completing the on-line application form.

An **administration fee of CZK 2,000** is charged for granting Czech citizenship (in certain cases this fee is lower).

- Those who pass the exam will receive a certificate from ILPS CU.
- Those who do not pass the exam can sign up for any other exam date.
